### RESIDENT REGULATIONS

#### Plumbing Stoppages – Mutual Two

Mutual Two shall pay the charges for all back-to-back sink stoppages in Mutual Two, unless the servicing plumber determines that the stoppage (whether back-to-back, side-to-side or an individual stoppage) is caused by the shareholder's negligence or carelessness. In that case, the shareholder shall pay the charges.

The following items may not be put in the garbage disposal: bones of any kind, banana or plantain skins, onion skins, vegetables (large pieces), broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, celery stalks or stems, coffee grounds, egg or nut shells, melon rinds, rice, GREASE, oil or greasy pan drippings, paper, plastic, or cigarette butts.

It is best that all garbage be placed into a plastic bag, sealed, and taken to the trash.

All toilet stoppages in Mutual Two are charged to the shareholder. Only two things should be flushed down the toilet: body waste and toilet paper. The following items may not be flushed down the toilet: diapers, body wipes, sanitary napkins, panty liners, hair, tissue, cotton balls, paper towels, cigarettes, cloth, or anything other than the above-mentioned body waste and toilet paper.
