If you enroll in Smile.Amazon.com and indicate your charitable organization as the Golden Age Foundation Seal Beach, every time you shop on Amazon, they will donate a percentage of your purchase to GAF without any additional cost to you.

Ralph's Reward program is another way to donate to the Golden Age Foundation. Sign up on www.ralphs.com. You will need your Ralph's Reward Card number to register or the phone number associated with your account . Before this past September, Ralph's offered to register people by phone which was very convenient for those who were not computer savvy or had no computer. Unfortunately, as of September 1st, Ralph's no longer offers registration over the phone. This can only be done online.

To help Ralph's members who would like to register and support GAF but are unable to do online registration, GAF will assist with your registration.

Beginning on Tuesday, November 6th, in the Clubhouse 6 Hospitality Center, a GAF Board member will be there between 9:00 and 11:00 am to assist you in registering for the Ralph's Reward program.

Assistance will be also be available on November 13th, 20th and 27th. The December schedule will be announced through LW weekly.
