SUBJECT: PURCHASE OF LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION SYSTEM

The Golden Rain Foundation currently uses a security camera system at the Main Gate, North Gate, and Saint Andrews Gate. This system helps staff monitor vehicles and persons entering and exiting our community. The system has been very helpful in identifying persons and vehicles involved in incidents.

Although the current system has been very beneficial, staff has found that our current security camera system has some limitations when it comes to identifying the license plates of vehicles. Situations where the vehicle is in motion, behind the light from the setting sun, or even the light from the vehicle's headlights limits the ability of our security cameras from getting a clear view of a vehicle's license plate.

Staff has determined that a license plate recognition system is needed to supplement our existing system and ensure that each vehicle that enters and exits the community is identified. These systems also have software databases that allow staff to search for particular license plate information or even partial license plates.

Staff researched several companies to find the most economical solution. Five security camera companies were contacted, but only two quotes were received:

Funds in the amount of \$20,000 were set aside in the 2014 Capital Acquisition Budget for a license plate recognition system. Staff recommends World Eyecam due to their extended warranty, being located locally in Orange County, and unlimited tech support.

Action by the Committee to recommend the Board consider the purchase of a license plate recognition system from World Eyecam in the amount of \$ 19,997.06 is requested.

SUBJECT: DISBAND POLICY 1920 SUB-COMMITTEE

At its meeting on August 1, 2013, the Security, Bus & Traffic Committee unanimously voted to establish a sub-committee consisting of GRF Director Carole Damoci, Physical Property staff, Gates and Patrol staff, shareholder David Lyon and support personnel to review and recommend a course of action and enforcement for Policy 1920, Traffic Rules and Regulations.

At its meeting on August 27, 2013, the GRF Board of Directors unanimously voted to establish a Traffic Enforcement Ad hoc Committee to study the feasibility of an enforcement system that would work in conjunction with current policies. The Ad hoc Committee is chaired by Ron Kravitz and members include Lou Krieger, David Lyon, Betty Osborne, Kathy Rapp and Anne Seifert.

As the Sub-Committee and Ad hoc Committee have similar goals, and with the understanding that the Sub-Committee has never met, it is recommended the Sub-Committee be disbanded.

Action by the Committee to disband the Policy 1920 Sub-Committee is requested.
