
GRF manages the Trust property that includes clubhouses, golf course, aquatic center, library, and named streets.

- Create their own budgets and monthly fees;
- Conduct fire/safety inspections of the interior of every home (unit).

Pets allowed, with some restrictions.

Co-Occupants must be approved.



GRF is the Management company:

- Manages the Trust Property
- Requires an initial one-time, per-person amenities fee for the right to use the amenities
- Requires a monthly fee



Guests are not allowed to use most of the amenities, such as the RV lot, aquatic center, fitness center, and golf course.




