GAF received two donations from FALW and the animosity party,

The Golden Age Foundation has been serving the Leisure World community for over 50 years. The Foundation is a non-profit, charitable 501 (c) (3) organization established in 1973 to enhance the quality of Leisure World life for our more than 9,500 shareholders. Our purpose is to make our community a better and happier place in which to live. When there is a well-defined need calling for a solution, the Golden Age will fill it whenever possible.

Over the years, through the support of volunteers, individuals, and organizations the Foundation has organized and implemented many programs that have benefitted our community at no cost to our shareholders. Our major income source is contributions from shareholders, either individually or through clubs and organizations.

Before the pandemic, GAF would receive from individuals, club organizations, and churches in our community but since 2020, it has decreased significantly and there are a total of handful donors. The FALW is one of them.

The Golden Age Foundation has seen a decline in donations during and since the pandemic. Due to this, our reserves have been decreasing at a rate that has caused the Board of Directors the need to reevaluate the programs to which we are currently contributing. We chose those that we knew were strong and would continue to operate without our support.

In spite of the decline in donations, there are a couple of bright news we would like to share following donations by one who would like to remain animosity.

The Cambridge West Partnership LLC donated \$5,000 to help the GAF programs such as Hospitality, Mobility Aids, Income Tax, Shredding and Battery Recycling, five major programs, and on behalf of the GAF, we would appreciate it very much.

The next donor is the FALW, Filipino Association of Leisure World. FALW was established in August 2009. The mission was to build a better relationship in a diverse community. It is a non-profit charitable organization geared to support the needs of the Leisure World community.

The main objective is to help Golden Age Foundation programs in assisting the needs of the community. At present, many active association members fully support whenever they tackle a difficult project. To be a member, you must be a bona fide resident of Leisure World.

FALW has a fundraising event in a year, the Annual Luau-Dinner Dance in September. FALW supports and hosts the annual picnic for all veterans residing in Leisure World. Even during these difficult times, FALW continuously made its annual donation to GAF.

FALW renounces violence as an instrument of organizational policy and adheres to a policy of peace, justice, freedom, cooperation, and unity with all organizations and individuals.
